ANNUAL REPORT

2021-2022

Mittal institute of education commonly known as MIE Mittal institute of education has started its session with full precaution and compulsory vaccination of both doses for all Students, faculties and staff members. New education policy was introduced in this session, so the main focus was on learning the new policy and re-designing the curriculum accordingly.

Key highlights for the session were:

- Total 222 admissions in 1st year in UG courses and 147 in Education.
- 100% result of final year student.
- After 2 years of Covid Shadows first time offline classes with 100% strength started.
- New education policy & internship is compulsory for all the UG courses.
- Vermi-compost unit has started at MIE.
- Remedial classes for weak students were taken.
- A personality development class was taken.
- Students of 1st year did internship in different fields like share Trading, Digital Marketing, Search Engine Optimization, Plant Tissue Culture, and Tally.
- MIE organized for the first time ekal (solo) and samuh gayan (group song) competitions under youth festival 2021-22 on 6th January 2022.
- A two day national Inter-disciplinary Conference on Information technology as a tool for commerce, management and entrepreneurship was held on 5th & 6th March 2022.
- Students visited a real forest under anubhuti scheme to know about forests beyond tiger.
- NCC & NSS students organized &/ participated in many humanitarian activities mentioned in their annual reports.
- A week long inter college activity was held from 1st to 7th September on the occasion of National Nutrition week about 200 students from various colleges participated in the activity in hybrid mode.

Demographic profile of the students

Total 369 students were admitted in Mittal Institute of Education for the session 21-22., 222 students in under graduate classes and 147 in B.Ed & M.Ed.

Though all the admissions are done through common portal of MP higher education (<https://epravesh.mponline.gov.in/>) the male female ratio is 1:1.13, which is an encouraging sign. 54% of our students are from reserved categories, in which 33.33% students belong to OBC category.
