Annual Report 2015-16

Educationist Prof. N.K. Mittal established Mittal Institute of Education Under The Nav Krishna Education Society, 22-A Professor Colony in Bhopal from 2009. The institute affiliated to Barkatullah University for regular full time two year course. NCTE released revised recognition order for Two-Unit on the dated 31/05/2015. It has been accredited with "B" grade by the UGC-NAAC in February 2014 and valid to till February 2019 . Institute Located in a beautiful campus spreading in 1.34 acre land oppt. BMHRC, Navibagh, Bhopal.

Admission Institute follows the rule and regulation of Higher Education regarding the admission process. Institute has also constituted admission cell that provide admission guidelines to enquiries. For the academic session 2015-16 admission conducted through online centralized counseling by Department of Higher Education M.P., admission Process started from 18 may 2015. In the academic session 2015-16, 46 students were enrolled in the B.Ed. course. The academic year started on 1st of July 2015. Orientation programme is conducted to welcome the new students to make them aware with the environment of the Institute, the course, rules & regulations and teacher educator with whom they have to go ahead in achieving their goals with a face to face interaction between teachers and students.

Academic Performance The B.Ed. session 2014-15 Examination Result was declared on July 2015, 98 Students were appeared in the examination out of them 68 students passed with first division, 13 in second division. Session 2015-16 first semester examination conducted in January 2016. 42 out of 46 students appeared in examination.

All students passed with first division. NCTE inspection held on 30/06/16 for M.Ed. course.

Student Welfare Activities

- Anti-Ragging Committee is functional in our Institute as per NCTE & UGC norms, to maintain a healthy and disciplined environment in campus. Many posters and messages related to anti-ragging are displayed. Faculty and students works to create a friendly atmosphere in and outside the campus. No case of ragging has been reported in this Institute since its establishment.
- Grievance Redressal Cell has been set up drop boxes have been placed at selected places. Besides the Grievance Redressal Cell, tutor-guardian meetings are also an effective means of communicating problems/suggestions to the administration.
- Placement & career Guidance Cell trained students for various interview and examination. In session approx 40 students are placed in various schools of M.P. and approx 10 students in other stream.
- Road Safety Awareness Program organized to generate awareness among students and teachers by poster & lecture organized by M.P. traffic police & NGO.
- Scholarship for ST, SC & OBC students provided by college as per Government norms. In session 2014-15. 22 OBC,SC, 01 ST students received scholarship.
- The college has a spacious canteen & mess with adequate quality of food and seating arrangement, a variety of Indian food and snack items are available for students and staff of the college at subsidized rates. The canteen kitchen is not only hygienic but also is equipped with modern gadgets. It is a place where students and staff can unwind and relax.

Academic Activities The Institute organizes curriculum, co-curriculum and extra curriculum activities including social service, socially useful productive works, personality and leadership development programmes. It emphasizes gender equality, women empowerment and technology – enabled teaching learning. It has organized programmes and activities to foster human rights and dignity of individuals. In the two

year academic session university classified the syllabus in semester system. Commencement of theory classes throughout the session from July to January smoothly. Students are given plenty freedom and democratic environment to express their views and are also taught to accept other view point with patience. Institute has well equipped Science Lab, Mathematics Lab, Psychology Lab & Education Technology Lab etc. it is being utilized by all the students. Students are acquainted with knowledge, uses, working and operation of various apparatus. Art & Drama Lab is adequately equipped with various tools and instruments. Lab gives them full opportunity to utilize their skills of working. This is a way to develop their creativity and enhance their overall personality.
