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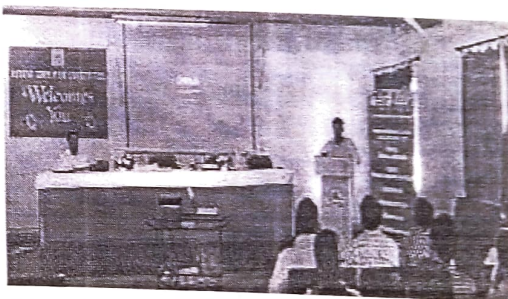

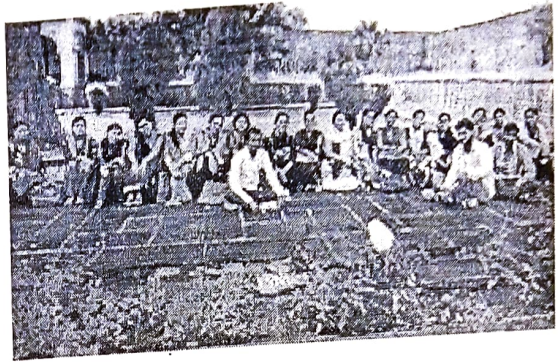
Report on Islam Nagar Trip

Venue: Multipurpose Hall

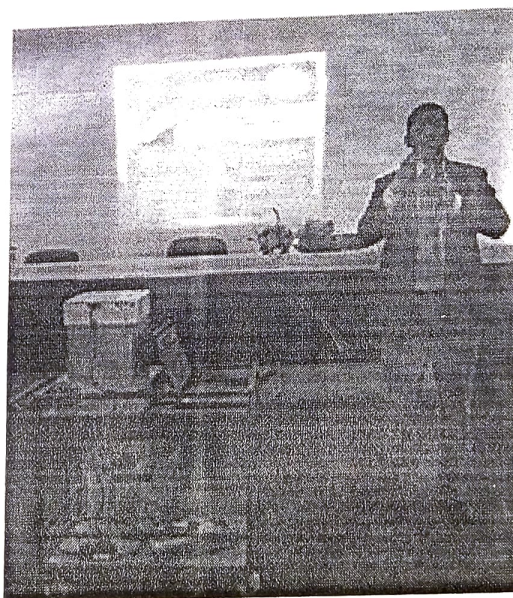

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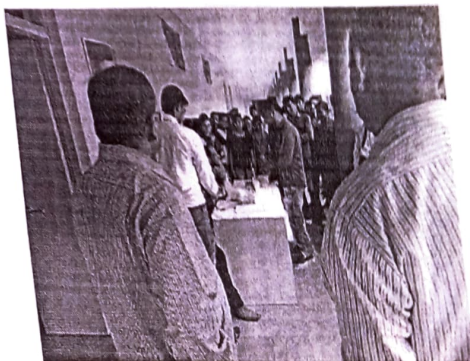
Report on the Blood Donation Camp

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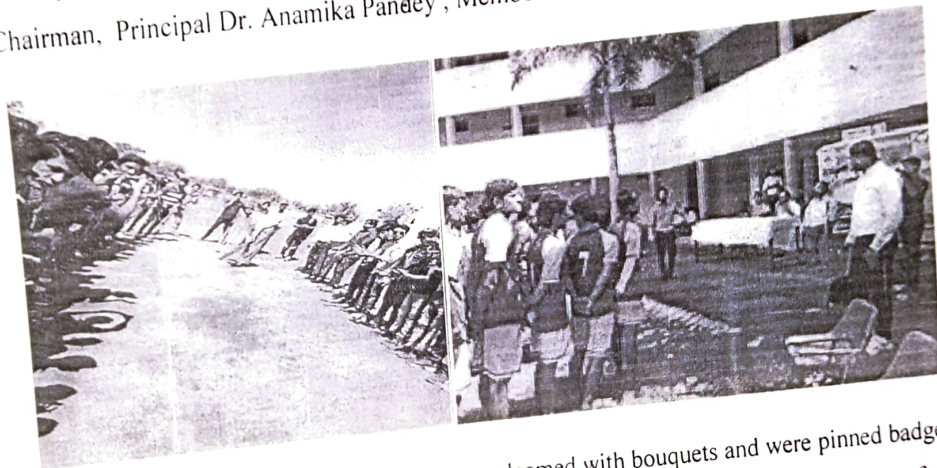
