

In their presentation they covered -

- Grey water can be defined as any domestic wastewater produced, excluding sewage.
- The main difference between grey water and sewage (Black water) is the organic loading. Sewage has a much larger organic loading compared to grey water.
- Major benefits of grey water.
- Reducing the need for fresh water. Saving on fresh water use can significantly reduce household water bills,
- Reducing the amount of wastewater entering sewers or on-site treatment systems. Again,
- Benefits the individual household, but also the broader community.
