# AN INTRODUCTION - MINIATURE WORLD MICRO ARTIST WILLARD WIGAN





Dr. Willard Wigan MBE has made his name as the' world's greatest micro artist' for his mind-boggling creations that are invisible to the naked eye. He makes micro-miniature sculptures. His sculptures are typically placed in the eye of a needle or on the head of a pin.

A single sculpture can be as small as 0.005mm(0.0002 inches). As a child with Dyslexia, he was ridiculed in class by his primary teachers for not learning to read. Wigan attributes his early drive in sculpting which began at the age of five. When he was 5, his dog destroyed an ant nest and his mind went into a fantasy world where the ants needed somewhere to live so he built a little palace for the queen and houses for the ants to have a party. He said that" making something small is like putting a pin through a bubble without bursting the bubble.

I go through misery to make my pieces. the pleasure comes when I finish and see the impact they have on people." His work tools are highly specialized and he can sit really still for hours. His miniature art works inspired millions to have faith in own's capabilities.
