One hundred eight (108) students of various classes were given the enrolment tests and on their performance basis Seventeen (20) students were enrolled in the first year Army NCC and (20) students enrolled for Naval Wing NCC. Ten (10) cadets were enrolled in second year Army Wing and Fourteen (14) students in Naval Wing.

- Among various activities planned and executed in the 2019-20 Session with respect to Swachha Bharat Abhiyan, A Program was also conducted on 04 <sup>th</sup> oct 2021 in MIT Seminar Hall to make the Students understand the Significance of Clean Environment and its impact on our lives.

### • Activities that took place in the Program were-

- 1. Pledge by all the Students as well as the Institutional members to maintain a Clean Environment wherever they work and live.
- **2. Plantation** of Saplings in the MGI Campus.
- **3. Informative Seminar** by Registrar Sir.

- The Seminar was attended by MGI Family in which Mr. Manoj Morya, Assistant Commissioner of Nagar Nigam Bhopal, Md. Sabbir Sir, Social entrepreneur for environmental culture and R J Roopak from Radio Mirchi were also invited in form of Chief Guests.
- All the dignitary members shared their valuable thoughts and experience regarding the Swachha Bharat Mission.
- A total of 120 students participated actively in all program activities in which Brand Ambassador for Swachha Bharat Abhiyan, Bhopal was also selected from our Institution - Deepak Soni, B.Sc PCM.
- On 7<sup>th</sup> of December 2019, An Educational Visit was organized to ICCC Smart City Office Bhopal to learn Garbage Management of the City. The students also got the Opportunity here to learn how the Garbage is collected from different parts of the City and then dispose it off in a Scientific Manner.
- Other tasks fulfilled by the Institutional Authorities with the help of the Students to attain the objectives of Swachha Bharat Abhiyan are as follows-
- 1. A team of **KCC** (**Keep College Clean**) an internal organization of the College (list of the students is enclosed) was formed. The students were distributed bags of KCC with the responsibility of cleaning the College premises and its surroundings. Mittal Group of Institute started the first successful cleanliness mission by brooming and picking the Garbage inside and outside the College premises.
- 2. On 10<sup>th</sup> of August 2019, Mittal Group of Institute organized an event "Polythene free MGI".
- 3. On 1st of October 2019, a Special Morning Assembly was conducted in which everyone took oath to keep the College and its surroundings

Clean. Inspirational Speeches were also delivered by Register Sir and Principal Dr. Malika pal M'am.

- 4. The students made an inspiring wall painting for the promotion of cleanliness on the birth anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi.
- 5. The College building has been renovated and proper arrangement of fresh water supply has been done.
- 6. Broken furniture and waste equipments have been removed from the College.
- 7. Old files which do not serve any purpose to the Institution are removed from the Storage and process to computerize the manual data is initiated so that there is least bundle of files to keep it minimal as well clean and easy to maintain.

## **CATC CAMP 2021**

#### **Combined Annual Training Camp 2021**

Combined Annual Training Camp or CATC is a ten-day camp organized by each Battalion twice a year. Every NCC cadet from school and college has to attend at least one of them to be eligible for NCC 'B' or 'C' Certificate exams that are conducted annually. It comprises many competitions between the schools and colleges of the unit.

This year 19 cadets of Army and Navy wing the ofMittal institute of Education ,Bhopal attended the camp that was organized in November 2020 by 1 MP naval unit and 1 MP CTR NCC unit atBansal College Bhopal. The camp focused on teaching both theoretical and practical subjects and learningsof NCC and general knowledge.

Theoretical classes in the camp covered the topics of Drill, Health & Hygiene, History of NCC, Firing, basics of Field & Battle Craft. Practical classes included lessons of Tent pitching, Disaster Management, Drill, Guard of honoretc and primarily focused on Wing specific activities. The camp acted as refresher training for the cadets who were also trained in basic skills of survival and emergencies besides other topics. Cadets were introduced to weapons such as a .22 caliber rifle and attended firing practices on selected days. Cultural and Sports events were also an important and integral part of the camp with relevant prizes and medals for winners.

The main competitions that were conducted included Squad Drill Competition, Tug of War, Debate Competition, Dance and Singing Competitions (Group and Solo), Firing Competition, Tent Pitching Competition etc. Cadets were also assigned the activity called "dogwatch" in the camp wherein two cadets are to stay on "santri" duty for two hours at any time given time of the day.

On the last day of the camp, the Prize Distribution Ceremony for all the activities was held where the winner of the competitions were appreciated and awarded with certificates, medals or trophies. The camp administration at cadet's level was divided into three categories: Camp level, Company level and College level. The following cadets were the part of coordinators team in the camp:
