TRIBAL MUSEUM

The Madhya Pradesh Tribal Museum in Bhopal Takes immersive journey through the culture of the local tribes of the state. With large colourfull displays, the museum shows the art, traditions, daily life, and customs of a large number of indigenous groups.

The museum has a particular focus on tribal art and how it relates to the culture. A musical instrument, for example, is also a part of an important ritual. A sculpture is also a tribute to a god or spiritual energy. For the tribes, everything is related to an invisible power and items are both practical and supernatural at the same time.

The Tribal Life Gallery has full-sized models of the tribes' houses and dwellings, large enough for visitors to go inside. In another gallery, stories of worship and sacrifice are portrayed through impressive art installations. Art facts from daily life are presented alongside cultural symbols that contain deep meanings passed through the generations.
